As part of a Design-Build team with J2 Engineering, Borrelli + Partners was selected by the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers Huntsville District to design a 15,620 SF Child Development Center at Fort Polk, Louisiana.

The LEED certified facility will accommodate up to 235 children ages 6 weeks to 5 years of age.

Borrelli + Partners' scope of work includes providing complete architectural and engineering services from schematic design through construction administration. This Child Development Center is a one story building which is divided into 3 quadrants to accommodate the particular needs of infants, toddlers and pre-school children. It also contains a commercial kitchen and two large indoor play rooms. The administration facilities and MEP support areas are housed within the building as well. A large exterior playground is included in the design.
